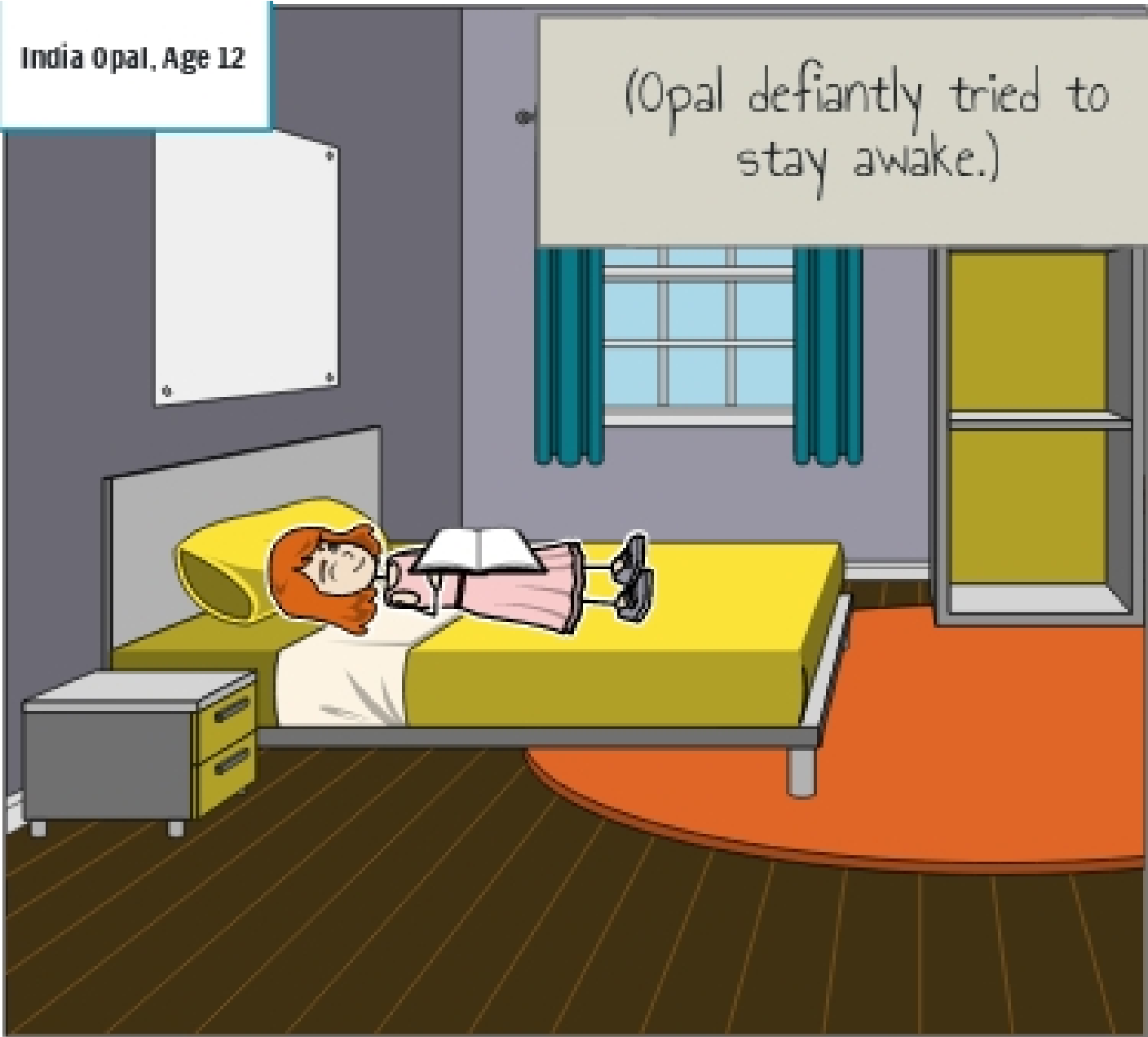
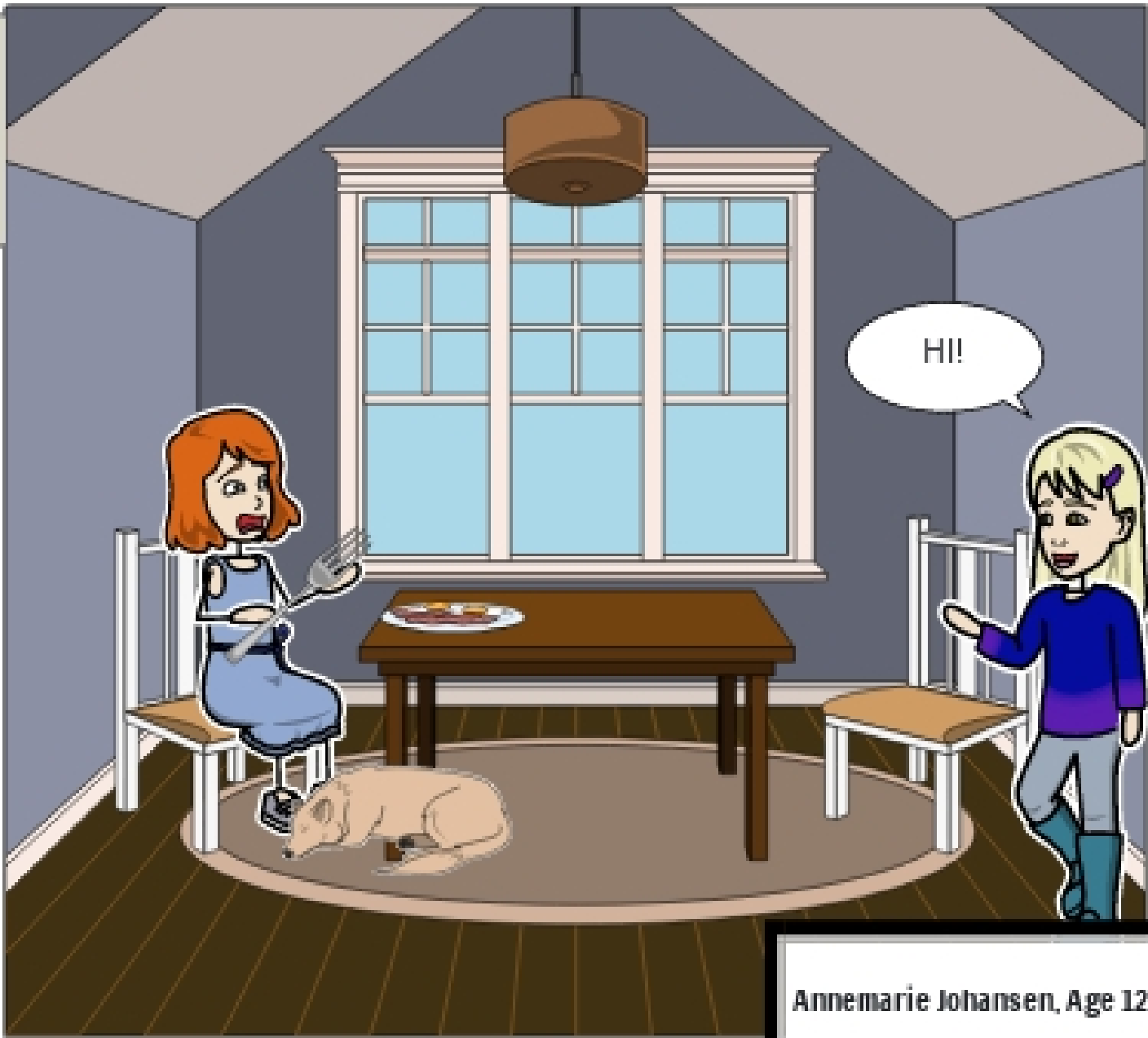


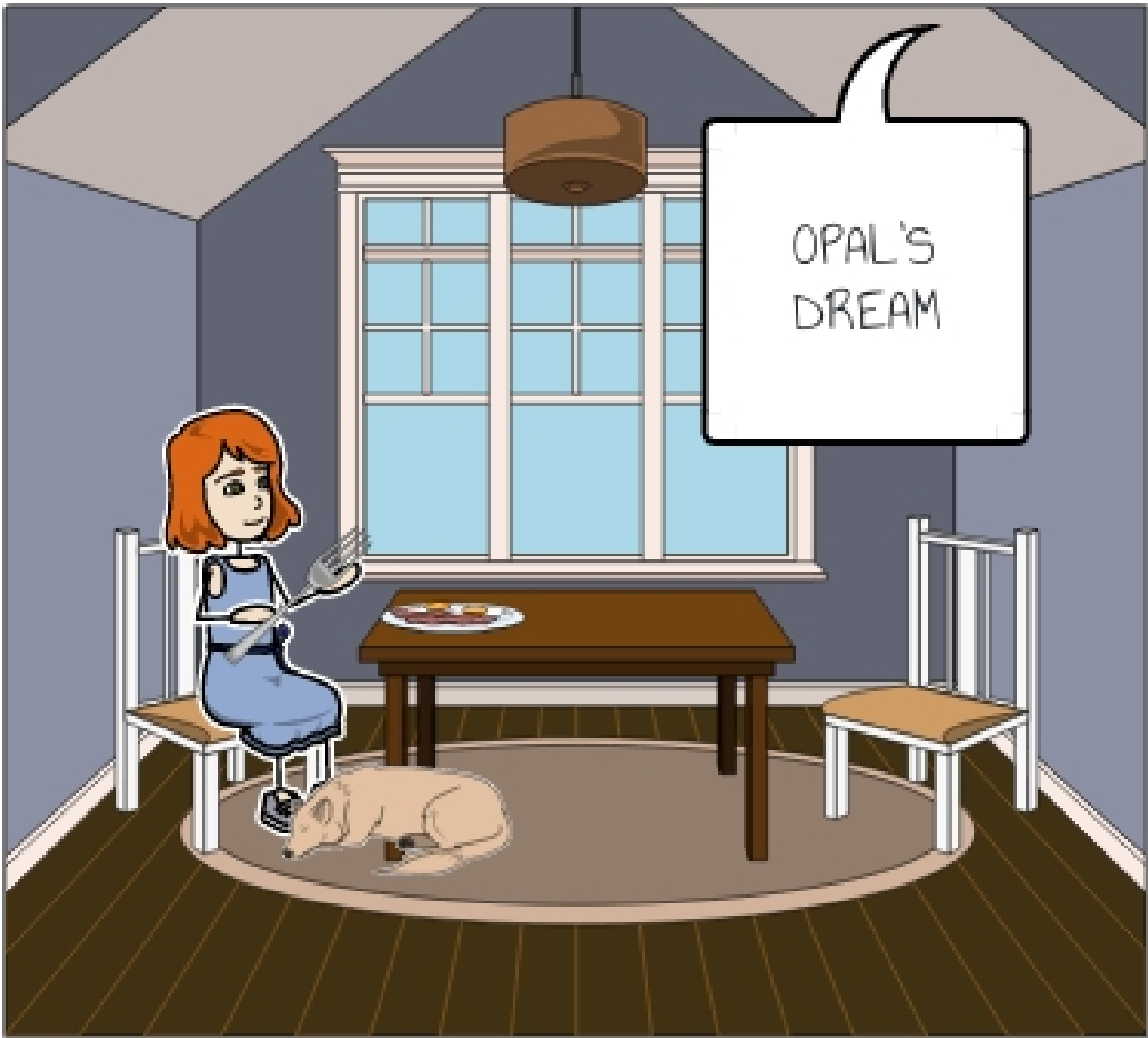

My name is Annmarie, and I saw that you were auditioning for the lead role in the Number the Stars play for Annemarie.




Well... tell me why you wanted to audition.

Yeah, I'm also doing it because the point of the play is to spread awareness for kids who were affected by war.

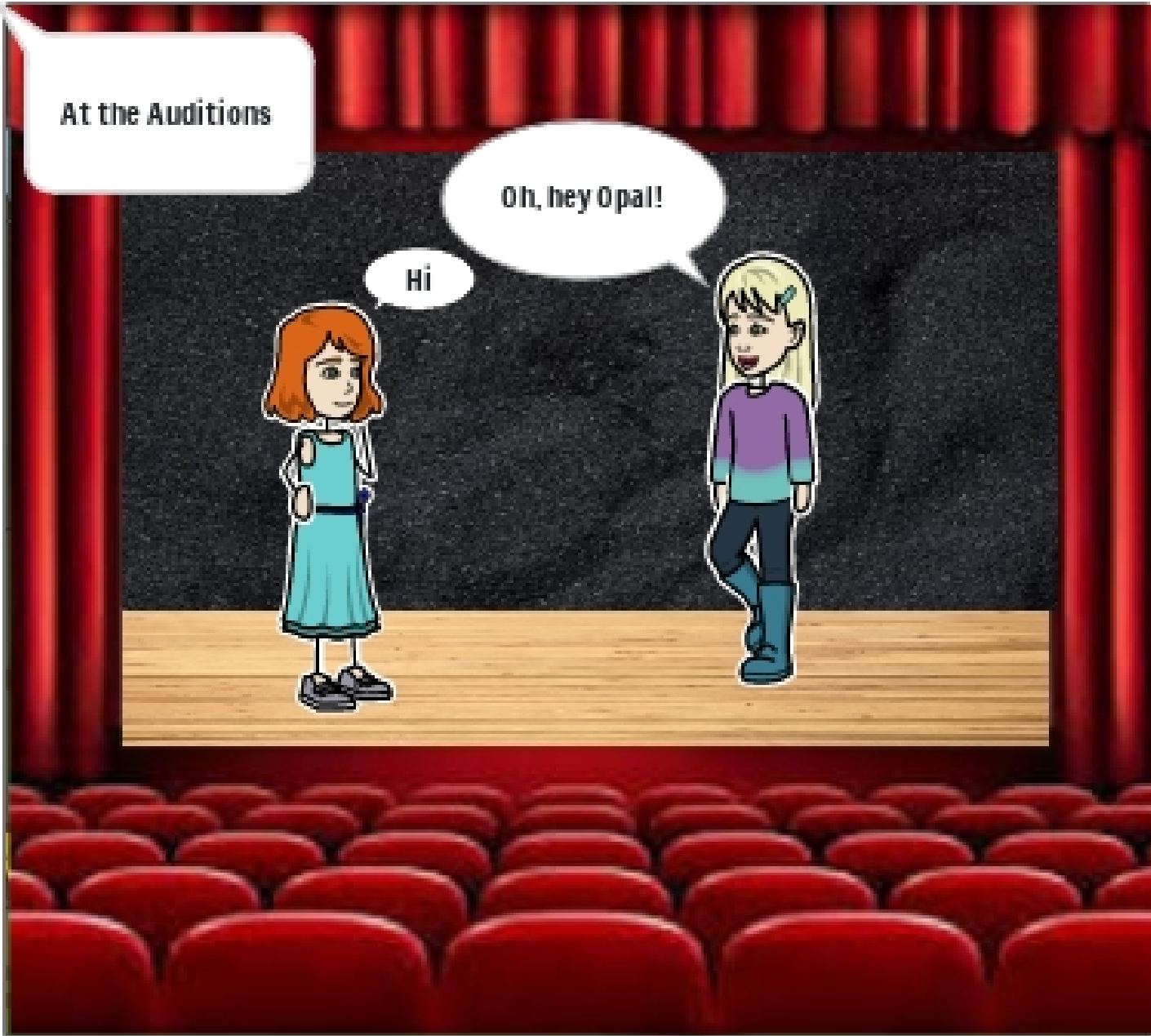


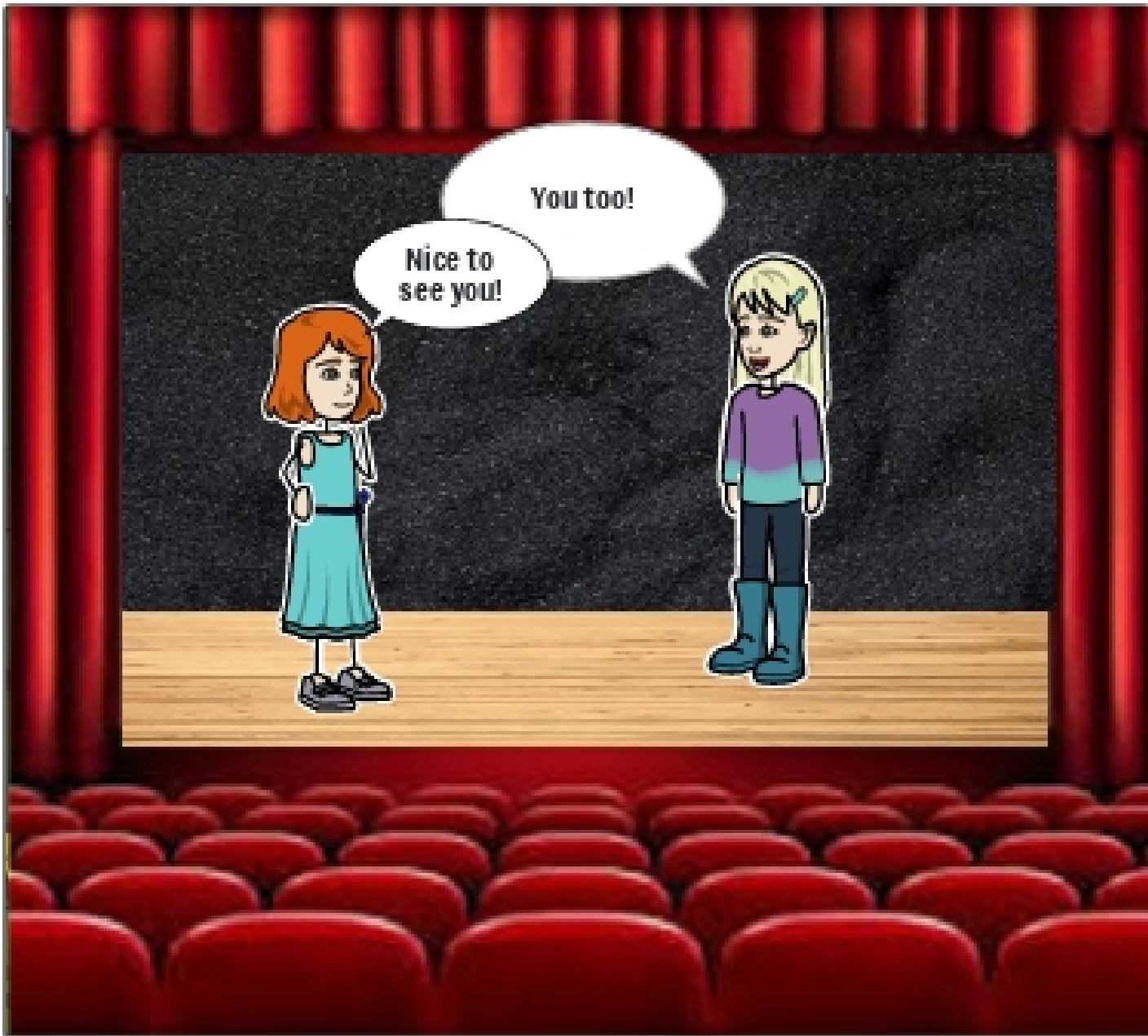
