


It was such a tragedy that so many innocent jews died.

My family helped some Jews and helped them escape from Denmark to Sweden!




im so sorry for your loss. In my family we didnt lose many family members. but it was so scary on those nights that nazis searched our house. I thought we were going to die!

most of my mom's family didnt make it out of the war. i feel so sad whenever i think about it!



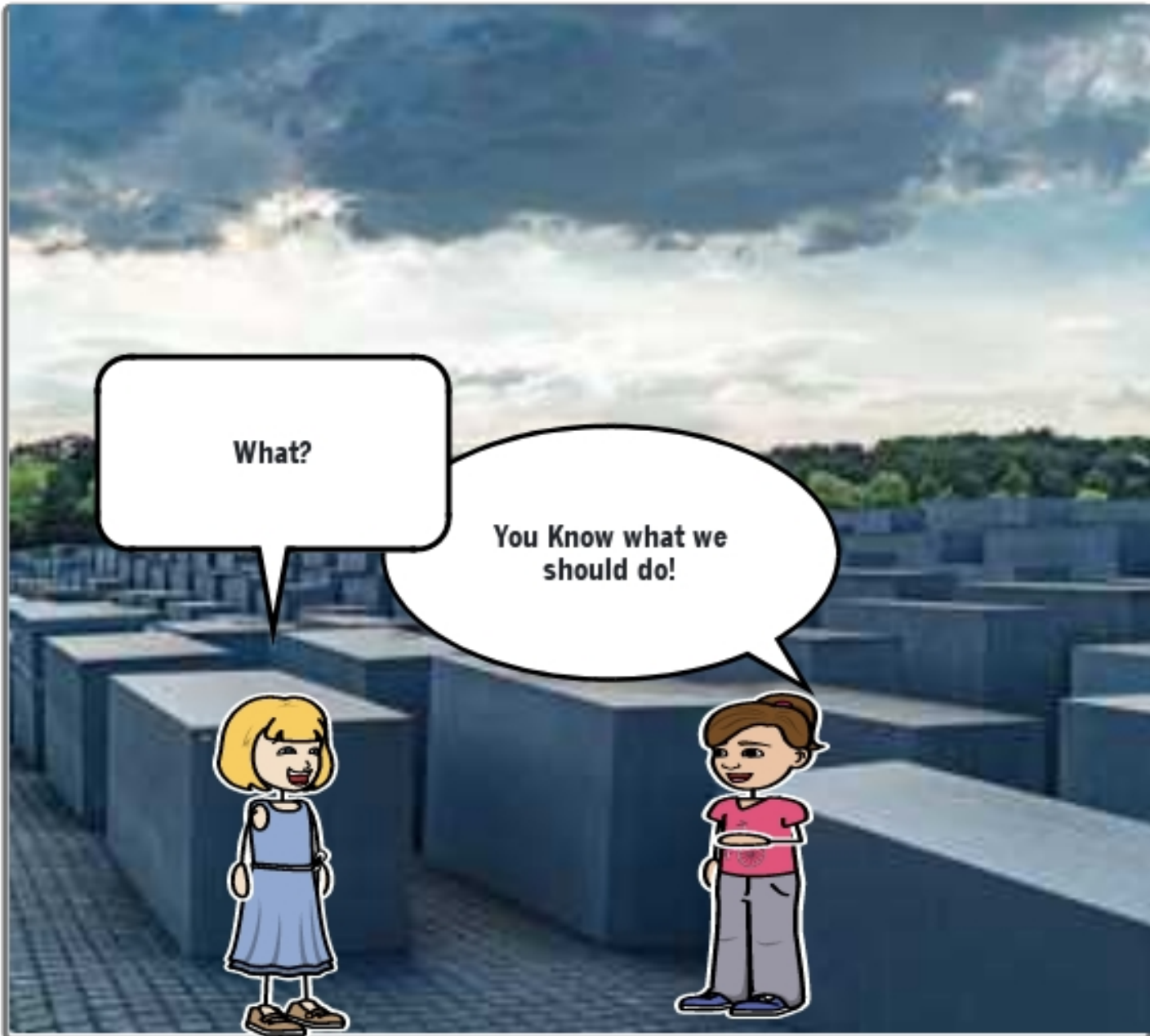
My perspective of the war was a horrible break out of soldiers coming into people's houses. Unfortunately my mom told me that that was also part of the holocaust
