

Hi! little girl what is your name? and why had you came to a civil rights talk?


Oh that is amazing that younger people are wanting to become civil right activist

but you will see tons of tragedies on the way if you want to become a activist


oh Annmarie the world is always cruel but we will need to persevere and have to get over it

oh ok we can sit down in a bench


hey Annmarie, i'm an older lady compared to you, do you want to sit on a park bench?

**you know I agree with you and my family was an activist and we had hid Jewish friend and her family from the Nazis**


**Im glad that you stand up for what you believe in**

to New York




so how was your day with
