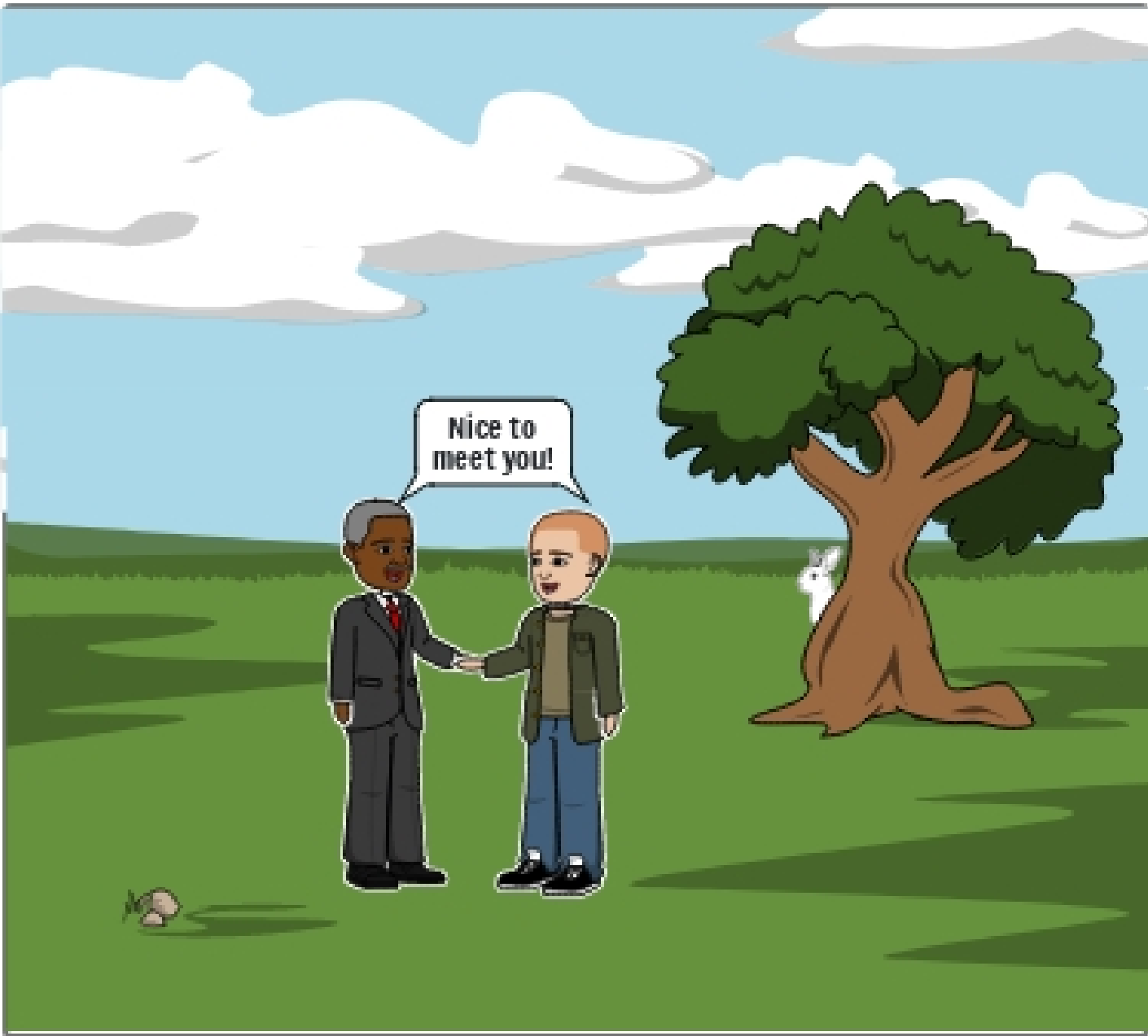




Entering Heaven

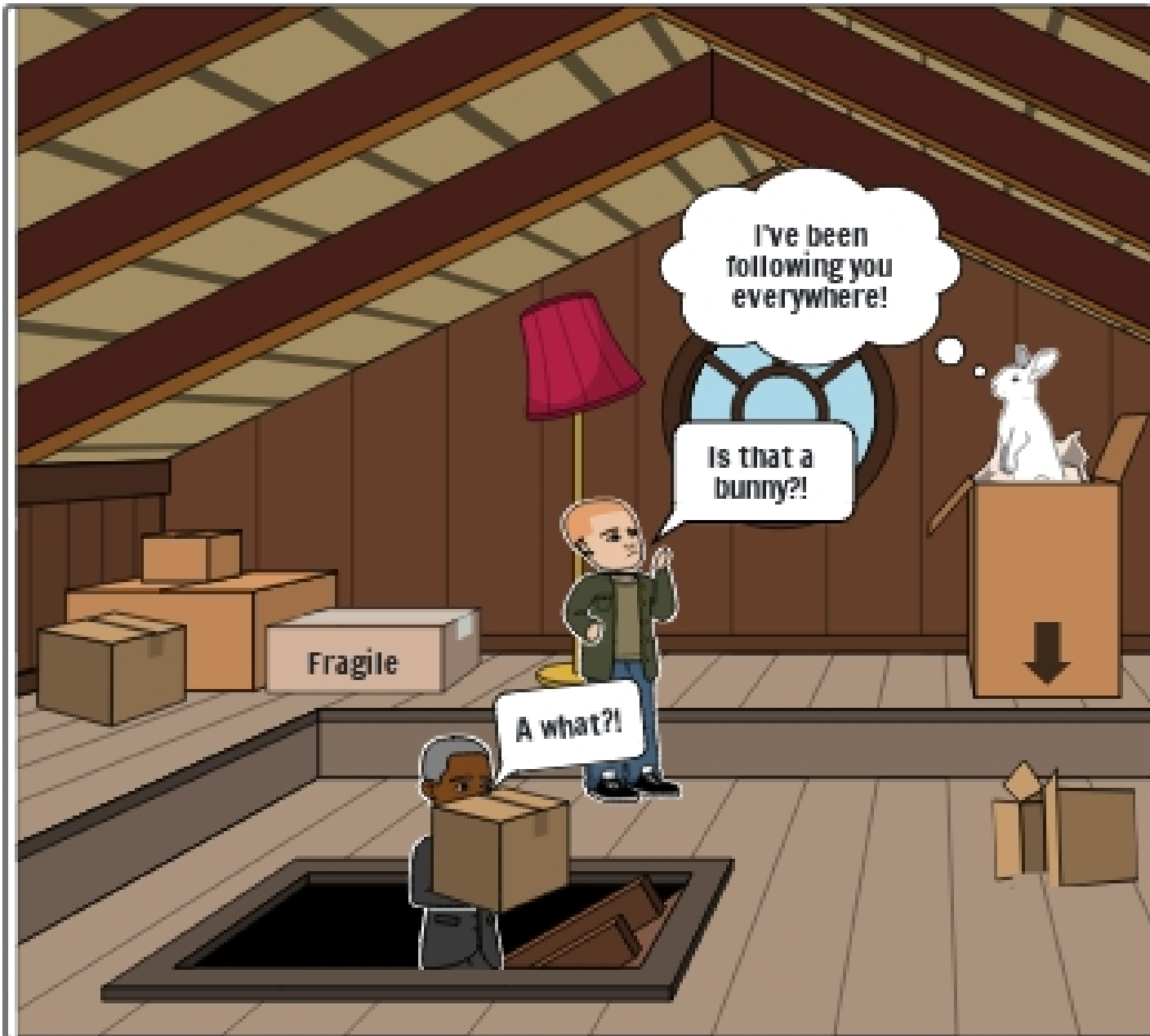








ugh I can't

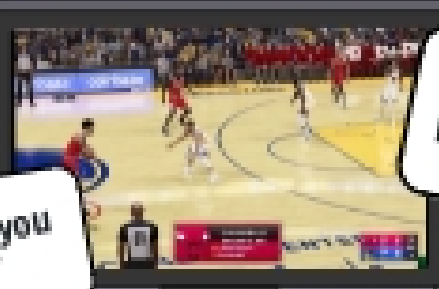
I don't know...
